Let us always turn to the true Light and let Him lead us home!

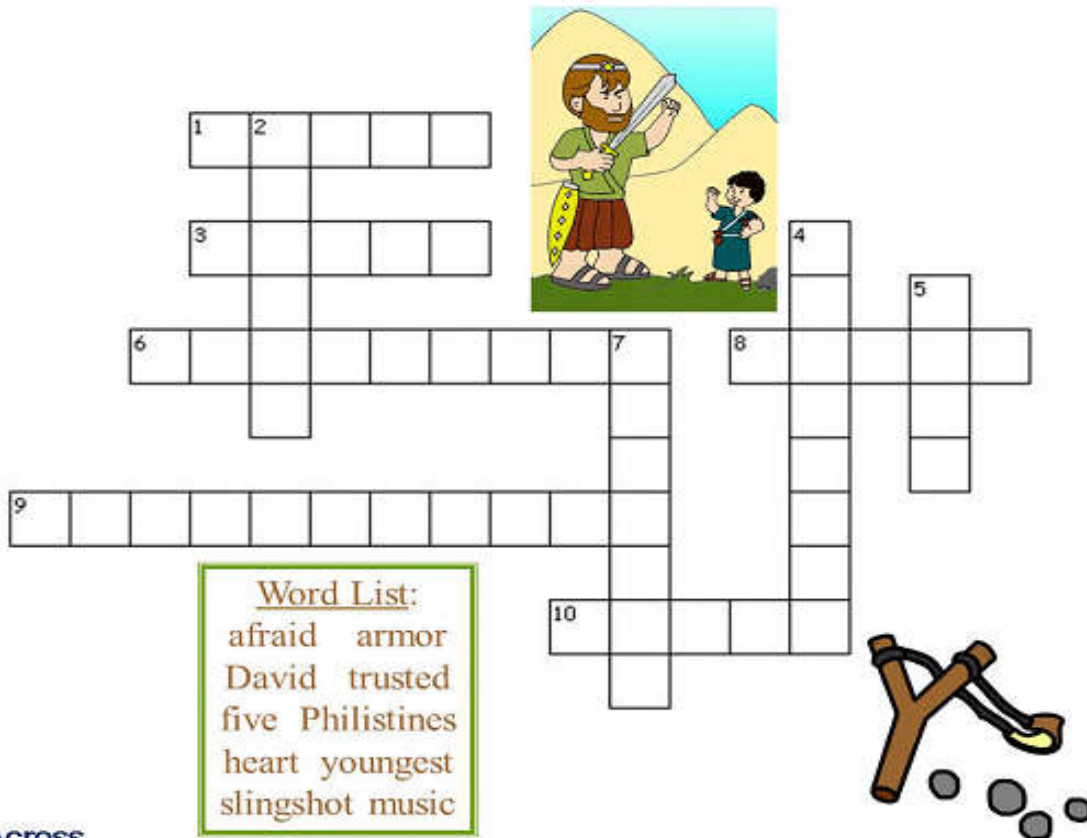


*Through many dangers,
