Dearest Child of God,

You may not know all about Him, but He knows everything about you.¹ He knows when you sit down and when you rise up.² He is familiar with your ways.³ Even the very hairs on your head are numbered.⁴ For you were made in His image.⁵ He knew you even before you were born.⁶ He chose you when He planned creation.⁷ You were not a mistake, for all your days are written in His book.⁸ It is His desire to lavish His love upon you simply because you are His child and He is your Father.⁹ He is your provider and He will meet all of your needs.¹⁰ His plan for your future has always been filled with hope.¹¹ He loves you with an everlasting love.¹² His thoughts towards you are countless as the sand on the seashore.¹³ He rejoices over you with singing.¹⁴ You are His treasured possession¹⁵ and He wants to show you great and marvelous things.¹⁶ If you seek Him with all your heart, you will find Him.¹⁷ Delight in Him and He will give you the desires of your heart.¹⁸ He is your greatest encourager¹⁹ and He will comfort you in times of trouble.²⁰ If you find yourself brokenhearted, He will be close to you.²¹ As a shepherd carries a lamb, He carries you close to His heart.²² One day He will wipe away every tear from our eyes.²³ He is your Father, and He loves you, even as His son, Jesus.²⁴ Through Jesus His love for you is revealed.²⁵ Jesus came to demonstrate that God is for you, not against you.²⁶
